

Fiscal Sponsorship Information  
For Groups That Are Not Tax-Exempt

Historic South Downtown (HSD) funding will be awarded to organizations that are nonprofits or organizations that are fiscally sponsored by a nonprofit. Any organization that does not currently hold tax-exempt status may submit an application to this funding round. However, no awards will be made without a valid fiscal sponsorship agreement. Organizations will be required to complete their fiscal sponsorship before funding contracts are signed and awards are dispersed.
